



Curriculum outline for interview presentation at St. Mary's Health System.

Prepared for interview at St. Mary's Hospital, Lewiston, ME

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Introduction:

This workshop will illustrate my comprehension of making a Great E-Learning Module. Where being an effective educator is an essential part of this position, I was asked by the interview panel to prepare a 5 to 10 minute interactive presentation on “Teaching Us on What Makes a Great E-Learning Module!” complete with a curriculum outline and any supporting materials.

Workshop Synopsis:

The objective to the PowerPoint presentation is to educate the St. Mary’s interview panel on “What Makes a Great E-Learning Module”. The presentation would show my understanding of the module creation process and then use two modules as examples of how I applied the concepts taught within my modules. Also how I made slight adjustments on delivery of the informational module and technical module.

Workshop Objectives:

The objective of the workshop is to illustrate to the interview panel my comprehension of the E-Learning module design and development process. This will be done using a PowerPoint presentation as a visual aid and present the content within the presentation to satisfy the following objectives. After viewing the presentation, the interview panel will get a sense of my comprehension of designing and developing an E-Learning module.

- 1.) Introduce the presentation purpose
- 2.) Introduce the six key steps to creating an E-Learning module
- 3.) Explain the six key steps to creating an E-Learning module.
- 4.) Introduce two module types I created
- 5.) Explain decisions made within the process on each module based on type of module.
- 6.) Conclude presentation, and open the floor to questions from the interview panel.

Instruction Methods:

The research required me to review various sources and find the most non-biased sources that don't favor one software package/technology vs. another. The instruction would include me presenting the material to the interview panel.

Content/Presentation:

The interview panel will be presented with a presentation that will illustrate my understanding of the E-Learning Module design/development process. The presentation will be divided into sections listed below.

Section II Six Steps

Section III Module Examples

Section IV Conclusion/Questions

The earlier sections within the presentation will introduce a concept and the later sections cover how that concept was applied to each of the modules. While presenting, I will check with the participants if they have any questions on any of the slides and/or explanations of each slide.

The connection between the six key points and the modules was very important because it would go into detail on how and where in the design/development process I used the six key steps. This also illustrated how I went through the progress and my comprehension of the overall design and development process.

Technology Used:

I used Microsoft PowerPoint to prepare my presentation for St. Mary's Health System. PowerPoint was selected because it allowed me to present in either a Mac or PC environment.

Outcome:

The outcome from this presentation is for the interview panel to leave with a good impression that I have a solid understanding of the E-Learning process.
